Scholarship Guidelines

Applications must be emailed to audubonboosters@gmail.com by March 15.

Late applications will not be accepted.

1. Sponsorship

The scholarship program is sponsored by the Audubon Sports Boosters. Funds are generated from the contributions of our members and concession stand proceeds throughout the year.

2. Eligibility

A candidate must meet each of the following conditions:

- a) Be a senior, in good standing, at Audubon High School.
- b) Plan to attend any accredited 2-4 year university, college, community college, or vocational/technical institute beginning in the fall of the student's graduation year.
- c) Parent/Guardian must be an active Audubon Sports Booster Club member (prior to December 31 of the current school year).

3. Scholarship awards

Up to four scholarships valued at \$500 will be awarded to selected AHS graduating seniors. Scholarships must be applied towards school tuition, fees, and costs. Scholarships must be used during the school year following high school graduation. Payment will be made directly to the recipient upon the award recipient's submission of a statement to the Booster Club Treasurer.

4. Criteria for Selection

In awarding scholarships, the Audubon Sports Boosters shall evaluate the candidates based on the following criteria:

- a) Character, integrity, and personal qualities.
- b) Embody a well-balanced high school experience.
- c) Academic achievement.
- d) Additional, meaningful participation in an activity outside of school (work, community service, volunteer, etc.).
- e) Essay must be typed with double spacing. The font must be Times New Roman, no larger than 12 font.

5. Application must include the following:

- a. Completion of the attached [scholarship application](#) form.

6. Submittal of application

- a. Applications are due via email to audubonboosters@gmail.com by March 15. No late applications will be accepted.

- Essay must be typed with double spacing. The font must be Times New Roman, no larger than 12 font.
- In 300-500 words, describe how athletics at AHS has impacted you. Consider including the following:
 - What did you learn from your experiences?
 - How will you apply what you have learned?
 - How did athletics help you to realize your potential as you move further in your next academic pursuit?

Additionally, include any outside experiences (i.e. work, community service, travel, etc.) which has contributed to your educational goal.

- Provide your transcript through the first semester of your senior year.
- High School Activity Resume (resume should include your club/activity/sport participation)
- Two letters of recommendation:
 1. One from a coach, teacher, or administrator at AHS; and
 2. One from a community member, excluding family members and individuals affiliated with AHS (i.e. – employer, volunteer coordinator, pastor, etc.)
